

## 4. Operational Guidelines for Pauline Truth Theological Seminary

The operational plan for the Pauline Truth Theological Seminary (PTTS) is designed on a “Home Seminary + Online Seminary” model, enabling anyone to begin theological study from home.

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### Phase 1: Laying the Foundation for the Seminary (Establishing Vision and System)

#### 1. Clarifying the Purpose of Establishment

- 1) A seminary that teaches Pauline Truth (the Orthodox and Original Gospel)
- 2) Bible-centered education that transcends denominations and sects
- 3) A vision to make every home a seminary — the “Home Church Seminary” vision

#### 2. Defining the Seminary Name and Philosophy

- 1) Official Name: Pauline Truth Theological Seminary (PTTS)
- 2) Core Philosophy: “The Gospel was made clear through Paul. The home must become the training ground of the Gospel.”

#### 3. Core Operational Principles

- 1) Online-centered and home-based courses
- 2) Multilingual support (Korean / English / Chinese / Russian / Indonesian / Spanish, etc.)
- 3) Integrated system for video lectures, textbooks, exams, and assignments

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### Phase 2: Designing the Operational System (Registration, Exams, Tuition, Degrees)

#### 1. Registration Method

- 1) Open online registration for all (faith confession, application form, short self-introduction video)
- 2) Simple “entrance interview” or “faith confirmation essay” required upon admission

#### 2. Examination System

- 1) Online exams for each subject (multiple-choice + essay)
- 2) Includes grades for assignments and class discussions

3) Continuous assessments + final comprehensive evaluation system

### 3. Tuition Policy

- 1) Basic principle: Based on dedication and voluntary support
- 2) Tuition flexibility or scholarship options based on regional economic conditions
- 3) Sponsorship program operated through donations and offerings

### 4. Degree Conferral

Upon completion of each official program, degree certificates will be awarded (with options for online/offline graduation ceremonies):

Stage 1: Certificate(Basic Course)

Stage 2: Diploma / Bachelor

Stage 3: Master of Theology (M.Th)

Stage 4: Doctor of Theology (Th.D)

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### Phase 3: Curriculum Structure

#### 1. Undergraduate Program (Bachelor, 4-year course)

- Courses: Pauline Theology, Introduction to Old & New Testaments, Church History, Systematic Theology, Pneumatology, Eschatology, Doctrine of Giving, etc.
- 8 semesters in total + final thesis project

#### 2. Graduate Programs (Master / Doctoral)

- Biblical language studies, thesis writing methods, advanced Pauline Theology, critique of modern theology, and related research

#### 3. Home Church & Mission Leader Training

- Practical ministry application and field training (includes online practicum)

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### Phase 4: Building the Implementation Platform

#### 1. Website and Platform Development

- 1) Integrated system for registration, learning, testing, and lecture access  
Use of platforms such as Zoom, YouTube, and HeyGen for video lectures
- 2) Downloadable lecture notes, PPTs, PDFs, Word files, and translated materials

## 2. Media & Studio Utilization

- 1) Guidelines for operating small-scale home studios
  - 2) AI-powered video lectures (using tools such as HeyGen)
  - 3) Training in video editing and content uploading

- 1) Spreading the vision “Every home is a seminary” to pastors and believers worldwide

- 2) 10-Year Goal: Establish representative home seminaries on every continent
